The basics: the clubs main aims remain unchanged and are;

- To offer affordable and inclusive surfing opportunities for young people living in the Conwy Valley area
- Provide participants with skills in surfing and, where practical, in water safety and beach lifeguarding
- Develop and encourage members to gain life skills, employment and work experience
- Due to limited spaces and high demand we ask that members pay for all planned sessions

Responsibilities of members, parents and guardians

For 2021 we request that for each participating young person there is at least one **Nominated Adult Volunteer** to assist with both regular club sessions and occasional Surf Snowdonia / Adventure Parc Snowdonia events that the club are asked to support. We have additionally strengthened the requirements for parents/guardians to remain on site at all times during their childs session or identify a nominated responsible adult.

Club activities for the 2021 season

For the 2021 season the club will run a regular 1 hour slot from 8-9am on SUNDAY mornings. The club will have access to three beginner bays and both intermediate and advanced waves, allowing coaching and surfing for all levels of ability. The following club structure will apply;

- The club will consist of both standard members and advanced members
- A structured development program will be in place to track progression and coaching
- A once per season charge of £12.50 per participant is made to cover insurance and registration with the National Surf Federation
- All WEEKLY standard sessions will have a cost of £5 and all WEEKLY Advanced sessions £15
- Payments will be in advance and charged on a monthly basis. We can now accept card payment.
- Outside of the high season we will have access to an additional hour, with an opportunity for club members to purchase additional beginner waves. Waves in this second hour will cost £5 for junior members and £10 for adult volunteers and parents, booked on the day and with priority given in that order (junior members-volunteers-parents/guardians)
